A draft tribal environmental impact report (TEIR) has been completed regarding a proposed plan to expand Hard Rock Hotel and Casino Sacramento at Fire Mountain. The expansion would include adding an indoor live music venue and expanding the back of house warehouse and office space.

## New Eagle Mountain Casino build kicks off in Porterville

Nearly 200 people were in attendance earlier this month for the groundbreaking of the new Eagle Mountain Casino in Porterville.

The casino, currently located on the Tule River Reservation in the foothills, will be moving 20 miles down the mountain near the Porterville Airport.

Located on 40 acres at 2760 W. Yowlumne Ave., the new casino will have 1,750 slot machines, table games, a 2,000-seat event center and a few restaurants on 100,000 square-foot property.

The D.C. Court of Appeals on April 16 upheld the U.S. Department of the Interior's (DOI) decision to recognize the Wilton Rancheria as a federally recognized tribe, and place its land into a federal trust for the tribe's casino.

The Wilton Rancheria and its partner, Boyd Gaming Corporation, broke ground last month for the tribe's future, \$500 million Sky River Casino on the former site of the "Ghost Mall" at Highway 99 and Kammerer Road. The tribe plans to open their casino on their 36-acre property in late 2022.
