A casino and hotel could soon be coming to Ridgecrest as the city and the Timbisha Shoshone tribe announced a resolution of all disputes between the tribe and the city. In the claim the tribe alleged the city was obligated to sell property in the 1400 block of China Lake Boulevard as part of the terms of a municipal services agreement the tribe has with the city.
