Residents of Redding are expressing concern on the proposed new site of the Win-River Casino. Residents have expressed concern that the resort would hurt the environment and attract too much noise. Following the hearing, on July 17 a public workshop will be held to discuss the proposed project to the city. This matter will be open to the public for comments.

Wilton Rancheria plans to open their casino late 2020 or first of 2021, on the 36-acre site placed in trust by the Bureau of Indian Affairs. The tribe has lined up financing for the \$500 million Wilton Resort Casino Spa.

Kern County has proposed an agreement lasting 20 years and worth nearly \$220 million with the Tejon Indians. \$13 million is for a joint sheriff's and fire substation and other resources for the planned Hard Rock Hotel and Casino. The proposed agreement went before the Board of Supervisors on July 23
