Barstow Casino and Resort one step closer to becoming a reality

A Barstow casino is one step closer to becoming a reality after council members voted 4-1 to update a service agreement with the Chemehuevi Indian Tribe during Monday night's council meeting.

"Staff had been negotiating with the Chemehuevi Indian Tribe over the placement of a casino and resort within the City since 2004/05, and on November 30th, 2005 former City Council Members adopted the initial Municipal Services Agreement (MSA).
