



Aerosol Monitor Loan Agreement

California's Clean Air Project (CCAP) fills requests to borrow the Aerosol Monitor on a first come, first served basis. Please make your request at least 3-4 weeks in advance of the date needed.

Borrower's responsibility:

- The care and guarded possession of the monitor
- Notifying **CCAP** if the monitor arrives damaged
- Returning the monitor on or before the due date
- Returning the monitor in adequate protective packaging
- Cost of shipment to and from **CCAP** via a traceable carrier
- Insuring monitor for the amount stated on the packing slip. The monitor must be insured for \$1500.00.
- Replacement cost of the monitor if lost or damaged while in the borrower's possession. Note: **CCAP** is not responsible for replacement of any monitor that is lost or damaged during return shipping.
